Social Contribution to Anandvan, Warora & Lok Biradari Prkalp, Hemalkasa



Team of EF members led by Er S D shinde visited “Lok Biradari Pralalp” at Hemalkasa, Dist. Gadchiroli, first time in 2009. We found that this project, headed by Dr Prakash Amte, has an unique identity. Dr. Prakash Amte and Dr Manadkini Amte after completing their MBBS have devoted their whole life performing emergency surgical procedures without electricity and taking care of health of Adivasi people. Lateron, project was transformed to Hospital, residential school, Ashram Shala and an orphanage for injured wild animals. Dr Prakash Amte was conferred with Padmashri and other Award for this philanthropic work.

Further team of EF members also visited “Anandvan “Project headed by Dr. Vikas Amte, brother of Dr Prakash Amte. Its an apex non-government referral centre for people afflicted with leprosy.

There were 2-3 visits to this project in subsequent years.

Our President Er. S. D. Shinde and his team was very much impressed with dedicated and fully devoted work style for such noble cause of social work in both the projects. They also witnessed all the social activities by visiting various work places in the project. Their noble works are being continued by next generation also.

Dr. Prakash Amte was also felicitated at Laxminagar Lawn, Nagpur when he received a prestigious "Ramon Magsaysay Award".
